CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Young called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. and welcomed those in attendance. He then turned the time over to the City Recorder for the Canvass of the 2022 Utah County General Elections in relation to Proposition #2.

SCHEDULED ITEMS

RESOLUTION - Acceptance and Certification of the 2022 Utah County General Election; Proposition #2

Mrs. Bates stated as the City Council they would be acting as the Board of Canvassers and will be asked to approve and certify the 2022 Utah County General Election in relation to Proposition #2. She continued by reviewing the final election statistics which included the following:

- Number of Eligible Registered Voters: 46,518
- Number of Ballots Counted: 30,514
- Voter Turnout: 65.60%
- Votes For: 8,639
- Votes Against: 21,423

Mrs. Bates concluded by indicating this is the highest voter turnout they have had in Orem and turned the item back to the City Council for discussion and approval.

Mr. Macdonald moved the City Council sitting as a Board of Canvassers for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the Utah County General Election results pertaining to City of Orem Proposition #2 held in the City of Orem on November 8, 2022 and approve by Resolution the

results of the 2022 Election Canvass pertaining to Proposition #2; Orem School District with the following results:

Proposition #2 – Orem School District

For 8,595

Against 21,337

and declare Proposition #2; Orem School District failed.

Mr. Lambson seconded the motion. Those voting aye: David A. Young, Tom Macdonald, Debby Lauret, Jeff Lambson and LaNae Millett. The motion passed.
